

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SCHOOL COMMITTEE

General instructions

- Volunteers should notify the core lead of any miscommunications or lack of cooperation from the schools.
- Volunteers should consider contacting the leads only in case of emergency and should instead use the enquiry form or mail to get in touch with them.
- To ensure clear communication, it is appreciated that only SPOCs speak with or report to leads.
- All data submitted into the spreadsheets, whether it pertains to students or visits, will be deemed final and cannot be changed.
- Action will be taken in response to any complaints or instances of indiscipline during school visits.

Selection and events

- Information on the in-charge faculty should be provided by volunteers on their initial visit mandatorily.
- A single student may take part in a single event. Unless the leads consent, exceptions cannot be granted.
- Theme for drama will be ಪೌರಾಣಿಕ ಮತ್ತು ಸಾಮಾಜಿಕ ಸಂದೇಶ and should be followed strictly.
- For group dances, only folk dances are permitted.
- For the main event, arrangements will be made for gunny sacks, clay, rope, rangoli and chess boards. On the other hand, schools or students must make their own arrangements for practice.
- Students in grades 4 to 7 should be chosen. In case of false identity, the participant/team will be disqualified.
- There will be arrangements for transportation as well as breakfast, lunch and snacks at the venue.

- Either the school or the students should organize the costumes for the drama and dance.
- Volunteers should ensure staying in contact with the students for announcements and follow up. (Phone or WhatsApp)
- Any sort of parent intervention must be handled by the school and not the SPOC or volunteers. Report to the core leads if situation demands.
